I. Rationale

Traditional educational delivery frameworks are no longer sufficient to prepare lifelong learners for an increasingly interconnected and digital-first economy. To prevent systemic obsolescence, academic institutions must transition from reactive modifications to proactive, structural transformations.

The International Conference on Global Trends in Education (ICG-TRENDS 2026) is established as a premier global platform to address these challenges. The rationale behind this international gathering rests upon four critical pillars:

Ultimately, ICG-TRENDS 2026 serves as a vital collaborative space. It brings together researchers, classroom practitioners, curriculum designers, and institutional leaders to challenge existing paradigms, share cross-cultural insights, and future-proof global education.

II. General Objectives

To achieve its vision, the conference will direct its proceedings toward the realization of the following three comprehensive objectives:

It aims to build sustainable, international networks for digital exchange, equipping educators with the skills to turn digital tools into powerful, culturally responsive teaching strategies.
3. **To Recalibrate Instructional Leadership and Supervisory Frameworks:** The conference will provide a dedicated space for school administrators, division supervisors, and academic leaders to share contemporary strategies for institutional management. The focus will be on building agile supervisory frameworks that foster academic excellence, support continuous faculty development, and ensure smooth career progression during rapid educational changes.

III. Registration Fee Structure

Critical Exclusions (Onsite Delegates):

- International and domestic airfare are **not included**.

- Daily breakfast and dinner are **not included** (delegates must arrange personal meals outside conference operating hours).
- Private taxi rides or transport to personal/leisure destinations outside the official itinerary are **not included**.

IV. Payment Deadlines & Financial Policies

- **Reservation Deposit:** A **non-refundable but transferable** deposit of **PHP 10,000.00** must be settled on or before **August 7, 2026 (Friday)** to lock in slot and hotel room configurations.
- **Full Balancing Payment:** The remaining balance of **PHP 15,000.00** must be paid in full on or before **September 1, 2026 (Tuesday)**.
- **Hotel Extension Surcharges:** Any cost associated with early check-in or extended checkout stays beyond the official conference window (3 days, 2 nights) will be billed personally by the hotel to the account of the individual delegate.

V. Travel, Visa, and Administrative Clearances

1. **Passport Validity:** All departing delegates must ensure that their Philippine Passports are valid for at least six (6) months beyond the conference dates.
2. **Indian Visa Requirement:** A valid entry visa is mandatory for all Filipino participants traveling to India. Visa applications must be filed **at least thirty (30) days prior** to the departure date.
3. **DepEd Travel Orders:** All public school teachers, master teachers, and government personnel are strictly required to secure an official **Travel Order** signed by their respective DepEd Regional Office before departure.
4. **Documentary Submission Deadline:** Copies of your finalized **Travel Order and confirmed Airfare Ticket** must be electronically submitted to the secretariat on or before **September 5, 2026**.
5. **Airport Taxes & Border Protocols:** Delegates are responsible for settling their Philippine Travel Tax (which can be paid online or directly at the airport terminal) and completing all Bureau of Immigration travel declarations/protocols prior to boarding.
6. **Luggage Management:** Ensure you purchase sufficient baggage allowance weight allocations through your airline provider ahead of time to accommodate institutional materials.

VI. Onsite Logistics, Currency, & Connectivity

- **Currency Exchange:** It is highly recommended to purchase Indian Rupees (INR) or US Dollars (USD) at the Philippine international airports prior to departure.
- **Local Connectivity:** Local Indian SIM cards can be easily purchased and activated at the arrival terminal of the international destination airport.
- **Personal Equipment:** All delegates and presenters are required to bring their own **personal laptops** for parallel tracking and session engagement.

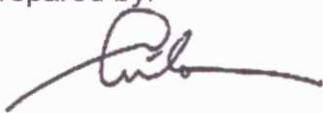
VII. Presentation Standards & Publication Privileges

- **Medium of Instruction: English** is the absolute official medium of communication for all lectures, research presentations, and open forum panels.
- **Slide Templates:** The organizing scientific committee will distribute a standard, unified Slide Template. Presenters must strictly layout their decks using this format.
- **Free Publication Perk:** All research tracks formatted under the standard **IMRaD** model and all formal lecture texts presented at the event qualify for **free publication hosting**, sponsored exclusively by **Aloysian Publications**.
- **Competitive Awards:** To champion academic excellence, a panel of international judges will declare winners for the **Top 3 Best Presenters** and **Top 3 Best Plenary Speakers**.

VIII. Dress Code, Conduct, and Security

- **Conference Sessions Attire:** Delegates must wear formal **business attire** for the entire duration of the academic sessions (October 22–24). Strict compliance with professional hygiene, neat hair, and proper grooming standards is expected.
- **Excursion & Networking Attire:** **Smart casual** attire is permitted for the city tour, off-site social gatherings, and casual outside business mixers.
