CONDUCT OF REGIONAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING

1. To provide updates on DepEd's programs and projects and to discuss policies and actions to address issues, concerns, and problems related to implementation, this Office shall conduct a Regional Management Committee Meeting on **August 27-28, 2026**. The Schools Division of Borongan City will host the meeting.
2. The agenda of the meeting are the following:
 - a. Updates from the Regional Director and Assistant Regional Director;
 - b. Five-Minute SDO Canned Video Report on the Status, Key Actions, Initial Results, Gaps/Challenges, Next Steps on the following:
 - Reaching and supporting the learners who need us most;
 - Strengthening Instruction and Ensuring Learning Continuity Programs; and
 - Ensuring Safe, Secure, and Child-Friendly Schools.
 - c. Five-minute RO Canned Video Report from RO Chiefs and Unit Heads;
 - d. PPSTA and PASS Updates; and
 - e. Other matters.

For the guidance of the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in the preparation of their 5-minute canned video presentation or PowerPoint presentation, kindly refer to the attached matrix.

3. The participants in the said activity are Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Regional Office Chiefs, RO Unit and Section Heads, and CID and SGOD chiefs, and RO and SDO assigned drivers. The RO and SDO drivers will also have their separate learning sessions during Day 1 of the REMANCOM Meeting.
4. A registration fee of **Four Thousand Pesos (Php 4,000.00)** shall be collected from each participant to cover food and accommodation expenses, chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel expenses shall likewise be charged against local funds.

To provide participants with ample travel time, Day 0 is scheduled on **August 26, 2026**, with arrival and check-in on the same day.

5. To strengthen the provision of technical assistance by the Regional Office through knowledge-sharing, collaborative problem-solving, and the identification of responsive interventions for the Schools Division Offices, Day 2 of the REMANCOM shall be dedicated to the Lakbay Division and Lakbay District. This activity will provide an opportunity to share best practices, address operational and program implementation challenges, and formulate context-responsive strategies that will further enhance the delivery of quality basic education services.
