2. The objectives for this activity are as follows:

- Compare baseline BoSY 2026–2027 against EoSY 2025–2026 Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) results to measure Key Stage 1 reading progress and identify widening learning gaps.
- Facilitate collaborative dialogues with School Heads and respective Division Chiefs to surface underlying instructional, administrative, and socioeconomic factors impeding literacy and numeracy recovery.
- Link school-level gaps directly to the appropriate Regional and Division Functional Divisions (e.g., CLMD, FTAD, ESSD, SGOD, CID) for immediate, customized technical assistance and resource allocation.
- Maintain an active, budget-resilient Delivery Unit oversight mechanism through monthly touchpoints, ensuring no priority school is left unchecked due to travel budget constraints.

- Deepen school-level engagement with the Regional Delivery Unit by involving both academic and administrative personnel, in shared accountability for learner outcomes.
