1. Attached is Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-386 from Carmela C. Oracion, Undersecretary for Learning Systems, dated September 3, 2026, regarding the implementation of the Executive Course on Leadership and Public Finance Management (ECLPFM) for Batches 5-7. The program aims to strengthen leadership and competencies in public management, public finance, and strategic leadership and is implemented by the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) in partnership with the Development Academy of the Philippines – Graduate School of Public Management (DAP-GSPM).

The course, meals, and accommodation of the participants shall be provided free of charge by the program.

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1. To further strengthen system-level leadership towards advancing learning recovery and sustaining quality education reforms across the basic education system, and pursuant to DepEd Order No. 11, s. 2019, "NEAP Transformation" and pursuant to Republic Act No. 11713, Excellence in Teacher Education Act," the Department of Education (DepEd), through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), has partnered with the Development Academy of the Philippines – Graduate School of Public Development Management (DAP- GSPM) to revive the Superintendents' Leadership Program (SLP), through the implementation of Executive Course on Leadership and Public Finance Management (ECLPFM).

2. ECLPFM is anchored on the principles of public sector governance, strategic leadership, and organizational effectiveness. It equips participants with advanced competencies to manage resources, design and implement policies, and foster adaptive leadership in a dynamic education environment. It also builds on DepEd's priority areas by integrating modules on Public Management, Public Finance and Budgeting, Personal Efficacy and Leadership, and Strategic Foresight and Futures Thinking.

3. This customized leadership development program for DepEd is being implemented in seven (7) batches this year, prioritizing Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs) and Assistant Schools Division Superintendents (ASDSs) who have not undergone SLP yet based on DM-OULS-2026-027, "**Profiling of SLP Completers and Non-Completers,**" released January 27, 2026.

4. In this connection, please be informed of the implementation details of the three (3) remaining batches, 5-7. Attached to this Memorandum are the following documents for reference and compliance:
